FINANCIAL CONDITION SUMMARY

Income DID Cover Expenses for 2018-2019

A 'surplus' year (income exceeded expenses by \$12,934). Overall a very good year.

Budget for 2019-2020 shows a breakeven

... we will try to hold the line on spending. We will continue to rely on volunteer labor particularly in the facility maintenance area.

Contingency (Emergency Fund) in place:

\$ 24,626 on deposit with Diocese. *This represents ONLY a 6% contingency to cover unanticipated emergency expenses or future deficits.*

Earmarked Funds on deposit at a local credit union \$10,260. The use of this fund is for food pantry support.

Capital improvements focus for 2019-2020 will include:

- MVAC unit for the Ruysser Hall
- A HVAC unit for the office building
- S Elevator for the Coleman Hall

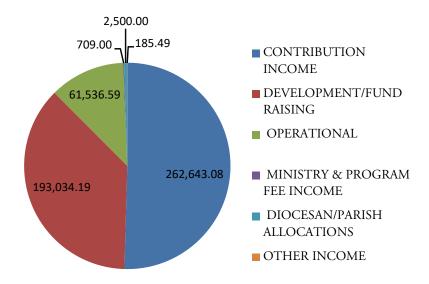
Note: None of these capital improvements are included in the 2019-2020 Budget.

2018-2019 FIGURES AND 2019-2020 BUDGET

ORDINARY INCOME (2018-2019 ACTUAL)

Our annual parish income this last year was \$520,608. The chart below shows the main sources of that income.

2018-19 ACTUAL ORDINARY PARISH INCOME

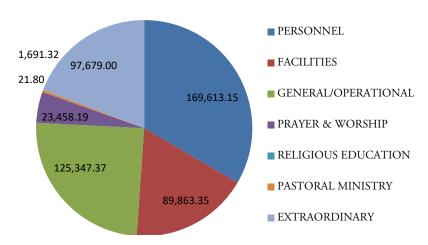


By far the biggest contributors to income are the weekly envelopes and collection plate (51% of the total). Other sources include development/fund-raising, operational, ministry & program fees and Diocesan/parish allocations.

Sacraments, Food Pantry, Marriage Prep, funerals.

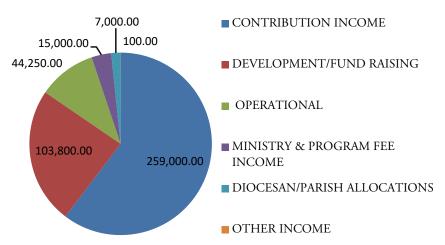
EXTRA-ORDINARY EXPENSE

ORDINARY INCOME (2019-2020 BUDGET)

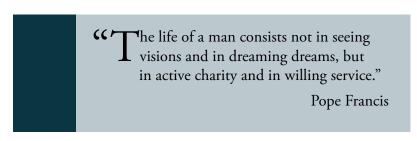
We are projecting an income for next year of \$429,150. This represents a decrease of \$91,458 from last year. Overall, we believe that our yearly income will stabilize somewhere between \$385,000 and \$400,000 for the next few years. The chart below shows the main sources of the remaining income.

2019-2020 BUDGET ORDINARY INCOME: \$429,150



Again, most of our income will come from the weekly envelopes and collection plate (61% of the total). We will again do our auction/dinner fundraiser which we hope to raise at least \$55,000!

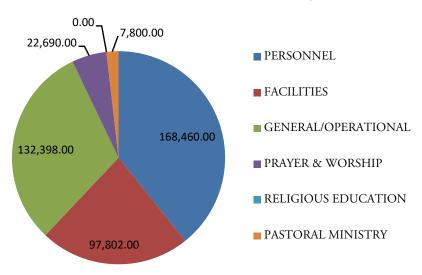
We hope everyone will continue to be generous contributors!



ORDINARY EXPENSES (2018-2019 BUDGET)

The chart below shows where the money will go ... we will try again to achieve a 'balanced budget' or another 'surplus' year. We are committed to NOT spend over our projected income. To achieve this position we will have to follow the budget closely. And we hope that weekly contributions will remain stable if not increased.
